Nice job of photographing a group of people without cutting off or cropping anyone in an awkward place.
Improvements: I did find the guy to the right with his hand out to be in a somewhat distracting position but when I played with the cropping, I decided there was no good way to crop him out without creating a very awkward cropping situation with the woman and child. It also really would be a shame to lose the color in his shirt and the red/orange of the wall on that side. Although I understand your reasoning for including the leaves at the top as a "frame" to the image, I decided it drew my attention more directly to the people to crop a bit tighter and get rid of some of the bright wall and ornate part of the lamp post that competed a bit for my interest. Technically, the depth of field looks good. The exposure no doubt was quite the challenge with dark skin tones, bright clothes, and the combination of shadows and highlights. Overall, I think you handled that challenge pretty well. I did try to burn in the whites just a little bit since they were really bright on my screen. I also did a little bit of dodging on the mother and child. Of course, photo travel is supposed to be more about conveying the time, place and events than the technical aspects, though, and you definitely have done a good job of capturing a time and place in this image.

Improvements: The image is slightly soft on my screen, but not too much so considering the circumstances, and sharpening it a bit did seem to help with that. Technically/compositionally, I am somewhat distracted by the bright upper right corner. I tried burning it in, but there just wasn't enough information there for that to work. I then tried cropping it out, but that made the image feel "off balance" to me, particularly since I did not want to cut out or cut off the shirt/laundry hanging out there. Thus, I'm not sure there is much I would recommend doing that would be a good fix. Overall, if the judges do follow the rule of valuing the story telling aspect more than the technical quality, the story does come through well, and I'm impressed by your quick reflexes in capturing it.
