Placing Half Dome in the upper right works well for me and maintaining the detail in the mountain sides down into valley at a time of low light is very well done. I am struck less by the pink sky (which is nice) than the lightness and warmth in the face of Half Dome.

Improvements: Two things seem possible that could improve the image: increasing the saturation in the sky and further warming the light in the face of Half Dome. I used Color Efex Pro (a Photoshop plug in) to add the saturation and I like the greater contrast been sky and rock that is achieved. Also, I used Viveza (another Photoshop plug in) to add warmed to Half Dome. I'll be interested in your reactions.
